

Woodside Animal Welfare Trust Policy

This statement explains Woodside Trust policy relating to personal privacy and information security.

Woodside Trust collects and stores the following information about you when you visit the website www.woodsidesanctuary.org.uk:

- The name of the domain from which you access the internet (for example, btinternet.com)
- The date and time you access the site, and the internet address of the website from which you linked directly to our site. Woodside uses this information to measure the number of visitors to the different sections of its site.
- Woodside will not obtain personally identifying information about you when you visit our site unless you choose to provide such information. If you choose to send email, registration, or other personal information over the internet, you do so voluntarily.

If you contact Woodside Animal Welfare Trust by email, telephone or letter you consent to Woodside storing the information and using it to contact you to pursue our lawful business together.

Woodside Trust will not disclose personal information provided to it except as follows:

- At your request, which may be oral, in writing, by telephone, electronic or other means we recognise.
- When disclosure is required by law, such as pursuant to court order, subpoena, legal process or government agency examination or investigation, or to protect or enforce our rights.
